- Severe Bleeding
- Loss of Vision



Quick Breakdown: Stroke Spot a Stroke ™ F.A.S.T. **FACE** Drooping **ARM** Weakness A STROKE is when the arteries in the brain is blocked or bursts. **SPEECH** Difficulty The brain does not get enough oxygen or **IME** to Call 911 nutrients.
