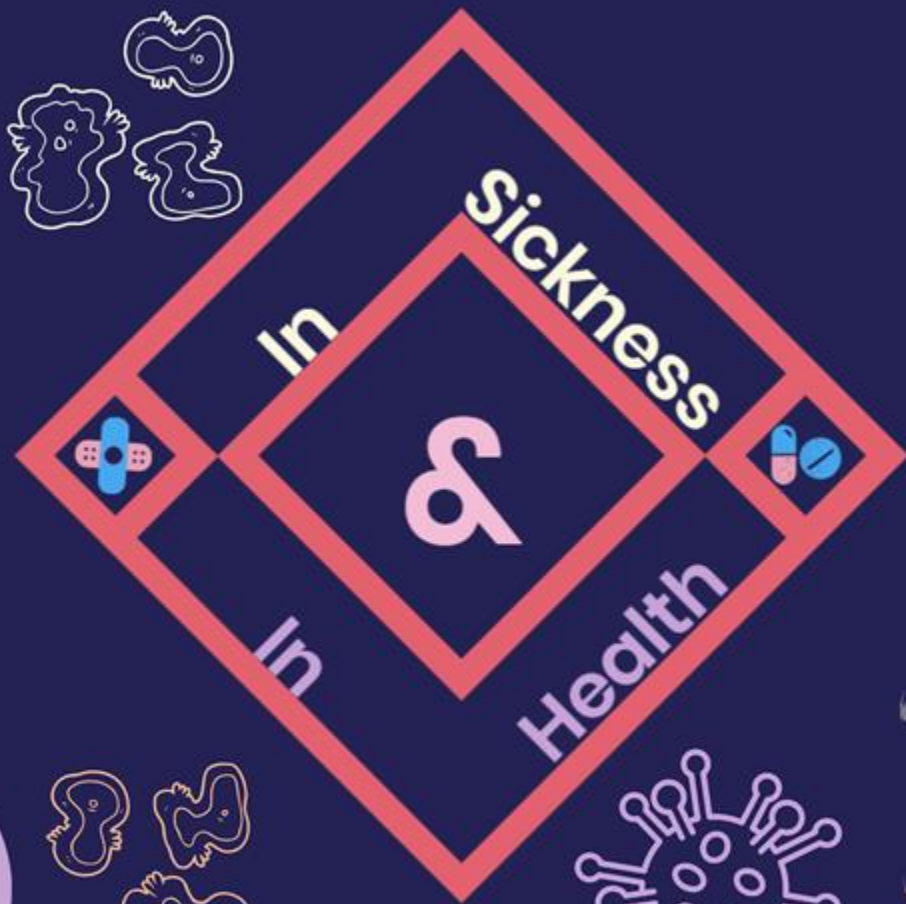
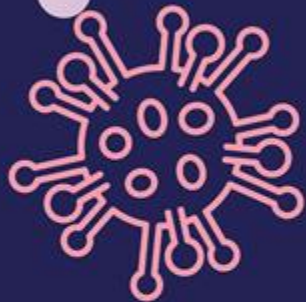

What is the Flu?

Severe respiratory
viral infection



Duration: 4-14 days

People at a higher risk



THE FLU

39,000,000 – 56,000,000
flu illnesses



18,000,000 – 26,000,000
flu medical visits



410,000 – 740,000
flu hospitalizations



24,000 – 62,000
flu deaths

Bacteria



Only grow & reproduce in host



Submicroscopic



Viral infection is systemic and spreads throughout body



Ex: Influenza, HIV, COVID-19

Bacterial infections are localized to 1 area of human body



Ex. pneumonia, tuberculosis, & food poisoning

Bacterial vs. Viral Infections

Antibiotics can only treat bacterial infections, NOT viral infections!

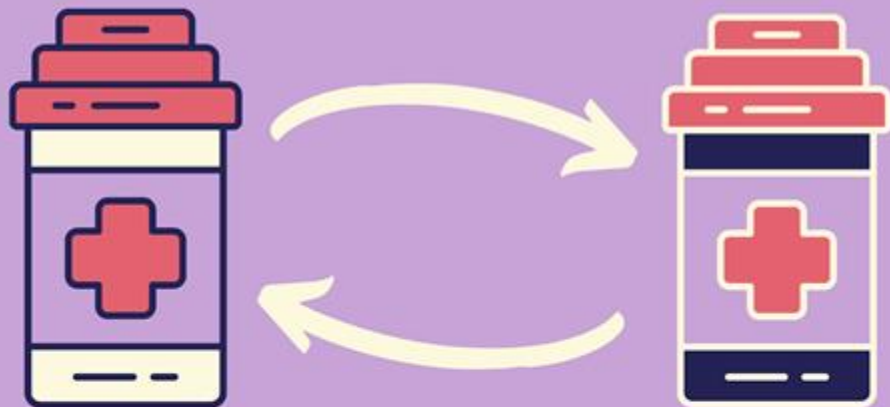
Common condition: What's got you sick?	Common Cause			Are antibiotics needed?

Strep throat	✓			Yes
Whooping cough	✓			Yes
Urinary tract infection	✓			Yes
Sinus infection		✓		Maybe
Middle Ear infection		✓		Maybe
Bronchitis/chest cold		✓		No
Common cold/runny nose			✓	No
Sore throat (except strep)			✓	No
Flu			✓	No

Diagnosis

Bacterial Infections:

- Antibiotics if prescribed
 - Antibiotic resistance
- Be aware of side effects
- ALWAYS finish antibiotic prescription





Diagnosis

Viral Infections:

- Alternating between Tylenol & Ibuprofen
- Zinc within 24 hours of symptoms
- Wait it out

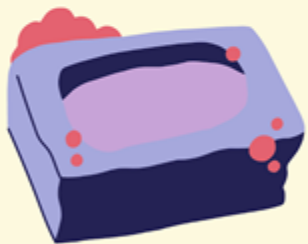

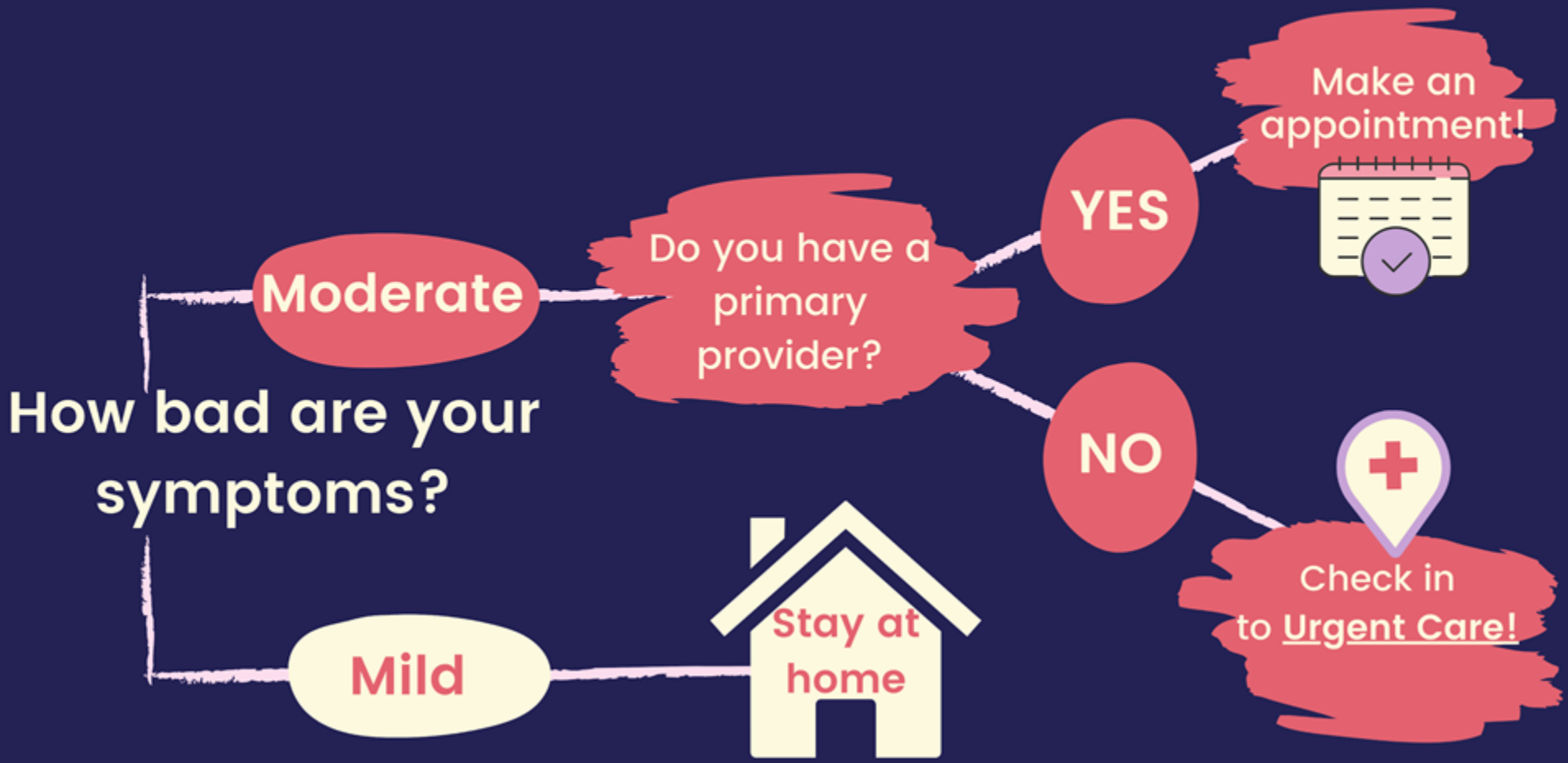

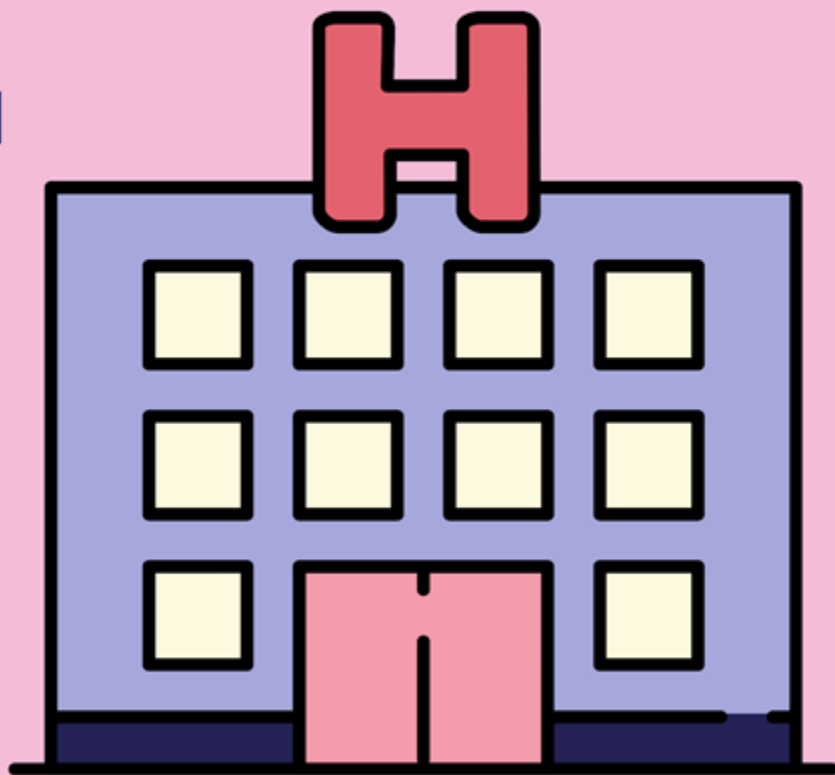

- Loss of Vision



Quick Breakdown: Stroke



A STROKE is when the arteries in the brain is blocked or bursts. The brain does not get enough oxygen or nutrients.

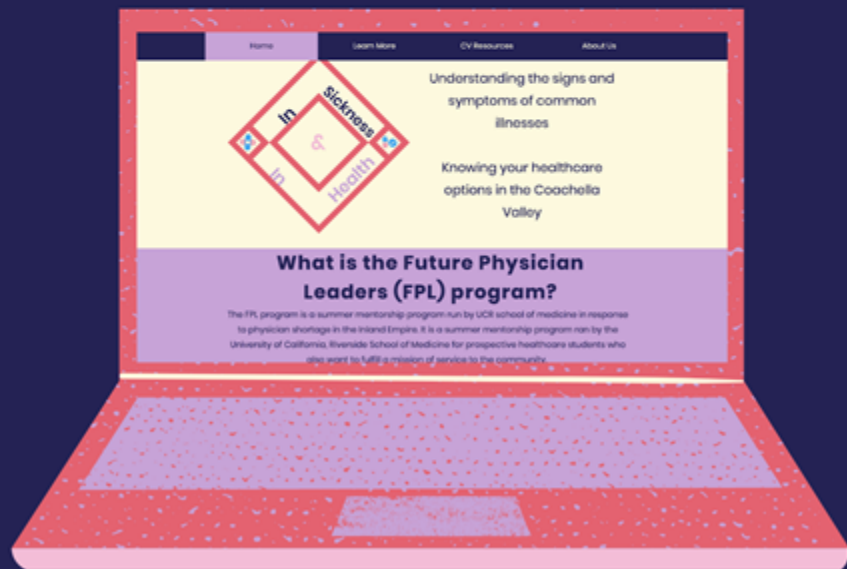
